

# 1xBet Aviator and 1xGames: Full Guide

1xBet Aviator and 1xGames 2026 — how Aviator works, in-house games, strategies and where to find them. Full crash games guide.

**TL;DR** 1xBet Aviator is a provably fair crash game by Spribe where a virtual plane ascends with a rising multiplier, and players win by cashing out before it crashes. The core decision is timing—each round lasts mere seconds—and the crash point is determined by cryptography before the round begins, allowing players to verify fairness independently. 1xBet also features 1xGames, an exclusive in-house collection of crash, fast, and instant-win titles built solely for the platform. The welcome bonus for new players extends to casino games, though contribution rates toward wagering requirements vary by game type. For players 18+, demo mode provides a risk-free way to learn the mechanics and test strategies before staking real money.

## What is Aviator

**Aviator is a real-money crash game by Spribe where a multiplier climbs until the plane flies off — cash out in time and you collect; miss it and you lose your bet.**

Aviator, developed by Spribe and launched in 2019, is one of the most widely played crash-format games across Indian betting platforms. It sits at the intersection of casino and live-social play: every round is resolved in seconds, the multiplier is provably fair, and a live feed of other players' bets adds a real-time social layer. 1xBet, founded in 2007 and operating under an international Curaçao eGaming license, carries Aviator as part of its full casino offering, which also includes the platform's own 1xGames titles.

### How the game works

Each round, a virtual plane takes off and a multiplier starts at 1.00x and climbs at a variable rate. The multiplier can reach 10x, 50x, or even higher — but it can also crash at 1.01x right after take-off. There is no fixed ceiling and no guaranteed safe level. The underlying result is determined by a provably fair algorithm before the round even begins; players cannot influence when the crash occurs.

- Round duration: typically 5–30 seconds of climbing, preceded by a 5-second betting window.
- The starting RTP (return-to-player) figure published by Spribe is 97%, though actual outcomes will vary per session.
- Multiple simultaneous bets are supported — up to two active bets per round on 1xBet.

### Multiplier and cashout

While the plane is in the air, your bet is live and accumulating. Your current winnings equal *stake × current multiplier*. The moment you press "Cash Out", that amount is locked in. If the plane crashes before you press it, the round ends in a loss. The tension between waiting for a

higher multiplier and the risk of a sudden crash is the entire game mechanic — no skill changes the random outcome, but timing your exit is the core decision.

### Where to find it on 1xBet

- Desktop: Casino section → Crash Games or search "Aviator" in the games search bar.
- Mobile browser: same path in the mobile-optimised site.
- Android APK: 1xBet offers a dedicated Android APK download (not on Google Play) — Aviator is accessible directly from the app's casino tab.
- iOS app: available via the App Store or direct link; casino section mirrors the desktop layout.

*Aviator is a seconds-long crash game where your only decision is when to cash out — the multiplier and crash point are pre-determined by a provably fair algorithm.*

## How to play Aviator

**Playing Aviator on 1xBet takes three steps: place a bet during the betting window, watch the multiplier climb, and tap Cash Out before the crash.**

The mechanics are intentionally simple, which is part of Aviator's appeal for players who find traditional casino games too slow. Below is a step-by-step walkthrough of a single round, followed by notes on the two features that shape most players' approach: Auto Cashout and Demo mode.

### Placing a bet

1. Log in to your 1xBet account and navigate to the Casino section, then Crash Games (or search "Aviator").
2. Wait for the current round to end if one is in progress — a 5-second countdown opens the next betting window.
3. Enter your stake in Bet Panel A. Minimum and maximum stake limits are set by 1xBet and may vary by currency; check the game interface for current limits in ₹ (INR).
4. Optionally activate a second bet in Bet Panel B — useful for split-risk approaches (see strategies section).
5. Click "Bet" before the countdown hits zero. Late bets are not accepted once the plane is in the air.
6. Watch the multiplier rise. At any point while the plane is airborne, click "Cash Out" to secure your winnings.
7. If you do not cash out before the crash, the bet is lost and the next betting window opens automatically.

### Auto cashout

Auto cashout lets you pre-set a target multiplier — for example 2.0x or 5.0x. When the live multiplier reaches that level, your bet is cashed out automatically without any manual action. This is useful if you step away from the screen or if you prefer to enforce a disciplined target without the temptation to hold on longer. Key points:

- Auto cashout triggers only if the plane reaches your target; if it crashes before, the bet

still loses.

- You can cancel auto cashout and switch to manual at any point while the round is live.
- Auto cashout does not guarantee wins — it guarantees the cashout *if* the multiplier gets there.

## Demo mode

1xBet offers Aviator in a free-to-play demo mode, accessible without depositing funds. Demo mode uses virtual currency and mirrors the live game interface including the live bet feed from real players. It is a practical way to get comfortable with the betting window timing, test auto cashout targets, and understand the crash frequency before wagering real money. No registration is required to try demo mode on many markets, though 1xBet may require a logged-in account on some regional builds — check the game lobby for a "Demo" toggle.

18+ only. Aviator involves financial risk; never bet more than you can afford to lose.

*Use demo mode to learn the timing before staking real money, and consider auto cashout to pre-lock a disciplined target multiplier.*

## In-house 1xGames

**1xGames is 1xBet's proprietary games library — titles built exclusively for the platform, not available at other casinos, covering crash, fast, and instant-win formats.**

While Aviator is a third-party title (Spribe), 1xBet has developed an in-house games portfolio under the **1xGames** brand. These titles are platform-exclusive, meaning they are not licensed to other operators. For players who already have a 1xBet account, 1xGames adds significant variety without requiring separate sign-ups elsewhere.

### Unique platform games

1xGames includes a broad range of formats, from simple instant-win cards to multi-player games with shared pools. A notable characteristic is the integration with 1xBet's existing wallet and bonus system — bonuses earned from sports or casino activity may be usable on certain 1xGames titles, though wagering conditions vary and should be checked in the current bonus terms. Examples of game categories include:

- Number-draw games (similar to lottery/keno formats).
- Dice games with configurable risk settings.
- Card games with instant resolution.
- Wheel and spinner formats with fixed multiplier tables.

### Crash games

Beyond Aviator, 1xBet's casino includes other crash-format games — both from third-party studios and from the 1xGames in-house range. The crash category has grown substantially across the Indian market due to its fast pace and the social element of shared multiplier feeds. On 1xBet, the crash games section may include titles such as JetX, Crash (various providers), and 1xGames' own crash variants. The core mechanic — a growing multiplier that can collapse at any moment — is consistent, but visual themes, side bets, and multiplier

distributions differ between titles.

- Some crash games offer bonus rounds or enhanced multiplier events not found in standard Aviator.
- RTP figures vary by title — check the game information panel before playing.
- Crypto payments are supported across the 1xBet casino, which suits players who prefer anonymous-style transactions.

## Fast games

The "fast games" category on 1xBet covers rounds that resolve in under 30 seconds — scratch cards, rapid roulette spins, and instant number draws. These overlap partly with 1xGames and partly with third-party content aggregated from studios like SmartSoft and Turbo Games. For India-based players, fast games are popular on mobile data connections because they require minimal bandwidth compared to live dealer streams. UPI and Paytm deposits are compatible with casino play including fast games, making the deposit-to-play loop straightforward.

*1xGames extends the crash and fast-games catalogue beyond Aviator with platform-exclusive titles that integrate with the same 1xBet wallet and bonus system.*

## Crash game strategies

**No strategy changes the random crash point, but disciplined bankroll management and consistent cashout rules reduce variance and extend your session.**

Crash games generate a lot of strategy discussion, and it is worth being direct: the crash point in Aviator and similar games is generated by a provably fair algorithm before each round starts. No betting pattern, timing trick, or "hot streak" reading can predict or influence it. What strategy can do is help manage your bankroll, limit emotional decisions, and set realistic expectations about variance.

### Bankroll management

The most commonly cited approach among experienced crash game players is the fixed-percentage stake. Rather than betting a set ₹ amount, you bet a fixed percentage of your current balance on each round — typically 1%–5%. This means:

- Stakes shrink automatically during a losing run, slowing down depletion.
- Stakes grow during a winning run, compounding gains proportionally.
- You avoid the "double-up to recover" impulse that causes rapid bankroll destruction.

A separate consideration for Indian players: UPI and Paytm deposits on 1xBet process quickly, which makes it easy to top up mid-session. Setting a hard session deposit limit before you start — and sticking to it — is a practical guard against chasing losses.

### Cashout timing

Two broad approaches dominate player discussion:

- **Low-multiplier, high-frequency:** Targeting 1.2x-1.5x on every round. At these levels, the plane crashes before the target relatively rarely, producing many small wins punctuated by occasional losses. The expected value per round at these targets is roughly equivalent to higher targets (because RTP is fixed), but the variance is lower — sessions feel more consistent.
- **High-multiplier, low-frequency:** Targeting 5x, 10x, or higher, accepting that most rounds will crash before the target, but a hit produces a significant return. Variance is much higher and bankroll requirements are greater.

A two-bet split is a variant approach: place a small bet on Bet Panel A with an auto cashout at 1.5x-2.0x, and a second smaller bet on Bet Panel B held for a higher target or cashed out manually. The first bet covers partial "insurance"; the second hunts for the larger multiplier. This does not improve the mathematical edge but does smooth some variance within a single round.

### What to avoid

- **Martingale (doubling after every loss):** In a game with no guaranteed floor multiplier, a short crash sequence can exhaust a bankroll faster than expected. A standard Martingale sequence requires unlimited funds to be theoretically sound — no player has that.
- **Pattern chasing:** Assuming the game is "due" for a high multiplier after several low crashes. Each round is independent. Past rounds have no effect on the next crash point.
- **Late cashout under pressure:** Waiting one more second because the multiplier looks "too nice to stop" is a common cognitive trap. If you set a target — use auto cashout to enforce it mechanically.
- **Unplanned session extensions:** "Just one more round" after hitting a target is where most session discipline breaks down. Decide your exit condition before you start.

*Use a fixed-percentage stake, set auto cashout targets before each round, and treat each round as independent — the crash point cannot be predicted from past history.*

## Bonuses and fairness

**1xBet offers a welcome bonus on first deposits and ongoing casino promotions; Aviator operates on a provably fair system that lets any player verify round outcomes independently.**

### Casino bonuses on crash games

1xBet offers new players a welcome bonus of up to 100% on the first deposit — the exact cap and any minimum deposit requirement are confirmed on the official 1xBet site, as these figures change and are not fixed in this guide. Bonus terms, wagering requirements, and which games contribute to rollover are subject to regular updates.

- Casino bonuses (as opposed to sportsbook bonuses) may be applied to slot and crash game play, but contribution rates vary — crash games often contribute at a lower percentage than slots toward meeting wagering requirements. Check the current terms before activating a bonus with the intent to use it on Aviator.
- 1xBet periodically runs reload bonuses, cashback offers, and tournament promotions that can include crash game titles. These are listed in the "Bonuses" section of the platform.
- Free spins are typically slot-specific and do not apply to crash games.
- Bonus terms, limits, and access methods change frequently — always reconfirm on the official 1xBet site before depositing.

### **Provably fair**

Aviator by Spribe uses a provably fair algorithm, which is a cryptographic verification system that allows players to independently confirm that the crash point of any round was determined before the round began and was not altered after bets were placed. The system works as follows:

1. Before each round, the server generates a random seed and shares a cryptographic hash (commitment) of that seed with all connected players.
2. The round plays out. After it ends, the full seed is revealed.
3. Any player can use the revealed seed to recalculate the crash point and confirm it matches the result they witnessed.
4. A client seed (from the player's browser) is also mixed in, ensuring neither the server alone nor the player alone controls the outcome.

The verification interface is accessible directly inside the Aviator game panel — look for the shield or fairness icon. This level of transparency is not available in most traditional RNG casino games, where outcomes are audited externally but not player-verifiable in real time.

1xGames in-house titles may or may not implement provably fair verification depending on the specific game — check the individual game's information panel for fairness certification details.

### **Responsible play**

All gambling, including crash games, carries financial risk. The fast-round format of Aviator and similar games can accelerate session pace compared to traditional casino games. 1xBet provides responsible gambling tools including deposit limits, session time limits, self-exclusion, and reality checks. These are accessible from account settings. Operators under a Curaçao license are required to offer basic responsible gaming tools, though the depth of enforcement varies versus locally regulated markets.

- Set a daily or weekly deposit limit before your first session — do not adjust it upward during a losing session.

- Use the auto cashout feature not only for strategy but as a discipline tool: it prevents impulsive manual holds.
- If gambling stops being entertainment and starts feeling compulsive, contact a helpline such as the iGaming helpline relevant to your region, or use the 1xBet self-exclusion tool.
- 18+ only. Gambling is not a reliable source of income.

*The provably fair system in Aviator allows any player to independently verify round outcomes — a meaningful transparency feature absent in most standard casino games.*

## FAQ

### **Is Aviator available on the 1xBet mobile app?**

Yes. Aviator is accessible on both the Android APK (downloadable directly from the 1xBet site, not via Google Play) and the iOS app. The game interface adapts to touch screens and functions identically to the desktop version, including demo mode and auto cashout.

### **Can I use UPI to deposit and play Aviator on 1xBet in India?**

UPI and Paytm are listed among 1xBet's supported payment methods for Indian players. Deposits via these methods credit to your main wallet, which can then be used in the casino section including Aviator. Minimum deposit amounts and processing times should be confirmed on the current payments page, as these details can change.

### **What is the RTP of Aviator?**

Spribe publishes the Aviator RTP at 97%. This means that over a statistically large number of rounds, the game returns ₹97 for every ₹100 wagered across all players. Individual session results will vary significantly above and below this figure due to the high variance of the crash format.

### **Are 1xGames titles different from regular casino games?**

1xGames are developed exclusively by 1xBet's in-house studio and are not available at other online casinos. They cover crash, fast, and instant-win formats and share the same wallet as the rest of the platform. Third-party titles in the casino (like Aviator) come from external studios such as Spribe and are licensed to multiple operators.

### **Does the provably fair system in Aviator mean I cannot lose?**

No. Provably fair means the crash point is determined before the round begins and can be verified by players — it confirms the game was not manipulated after bets were placed. It does not change the random nature of outcomes or the house edge. Players can and will lose rounds regardless of the fairness verification.

### **How does the 1xBet welcome bonus apply to Aviator?**

1xBet offers a welcome bonus of up to 100% on the first deposit; the exact amount cap is shown on the official site. Whether casino bonus funds can be wagered on Aviator and at what contribution rate depends on current bonus terms, which change regularly. Always read the terms attached to a specific bonus offer before activating it.
